

DIRECTIONS

The PICTURE SPELLER is an instructive as well as entertaining game. To play or teach, the Cards are first removed from the box and the Pieces containing individual letters, after being separated from the Pictures and also from each other, are jumbled together face up in the lid of the box.

In starting the play each player selects a Picture which is placed directly in front of him. The procedure is then similar to the working of a Jig Saw Puzzle. The Pieces containing individual letters are selected from the lid of the box in an effort to find Pieces with cut out portions to fit in the various cut out sections at the bottom of the Pictures. After three Pieces have been fitted on to the Picture it will be found that the letters on the Pieces will spell the figure shown on the Picture.

There can be no chance of error, as each Piece is notched differently except those with corresponding letters, which are shaped to be interchangeable.
