



MICKEY MOUSE OLD MAID CARDS

RULES FOR PLAYING

This game of Old Maid contains 35 cards—17 pairs (two of each picture), and one picture of Old Maid Clarabelle. Shuffle the cards. Deal one at a time to each player until all are dealt. Each player, sorting his hand, should first try to match up as many pairs as possible, placing each pair matched up face down on the table. The dealer then draws a card from the player on his right, and, if it makes a pair with any card in his hand, he puts the pair face down on the table. The player on the dealer's left then draws a card from the dealer's hand, making a pair if he can. The play thus proceeds around the table, the next player on the left drawing from the player on his right, until all the cards are paired and one player is left with the Old Maid Clarabelle card—which means he is the loser.
